LAC Shooting Protocol

At any session there must be at least 2 experienced adult archers* present for shooting to take place.

The container will only be available if a member of the committee or coaching team are present. All equipment detailed below will be stored outside the container.

At every session the following must be set up:

- Safety signs at entrance to field (not required if barn shooting only)
- Safety rope across track to prevent access into unsafe areas
- Safety chains across ungated entrance to barn (not required if barn shooting only)
- Shooting line with 10-yard gap on field range

Every range (separate for barn and field) at all sessions must have:

- An appropriate shooting line
- At least 1 experienced archer or coach
- An experienced adult archer agreed to act as field captain prior to any shooting
- NB if only the field or the barn are in use then there must be at least 2 experienced adult archers on that range

All archers are expected to:

- Follow the AGB rules of shooting (available on the AGB website)
- Follow the rules of etiquette (available on the LAC website)
- Arrive in time to help with range setup
- Participate in range take down
- Advise a member of the committee or coaching team of any issues with club equipment
- Advise a member of the committee or coaching team of any breached of the above

*An experienced adult archer is defined as someone over 18 who has shot with the club for at least 3 months after joining
